7. The school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Board's class X Examination from the year mentioned above without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the nonsponsoring of the candidates. Failure to do so will lead to suo moto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for secondary Examination granted by the Board.

- 10. Service conditions, pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be at least at par with that of corresponding categories of employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
- 11. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
- 12. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examination by providing the necessary accommodations i.e. Rooms, Halls, etc. available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charges if required.
- The school will spare sufficient teachers for invigilation purpose at the examinations of the Board, as may be required.
- 14. The school will spare its teachers for evaluation of answer-books for the Board's examinations, if required.
- 15. The school will provide Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board.
- 16. The school will abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
- 17. The school should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers or computer student ratio of 1:20 and proper software alongwith facility of Broad Band Connectivity with the feature of internet always on from any service provider.
- 18. The school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the Persons with Disabilities Act -1995'.
- 19. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
